Subject: Presentation by experts

As we have discussed, we would like to invite you to the meeting where of experts from two different sides will make presentation and conduct discuss related to Amulsar Gold Mine. The main topic of the discussion will be generation and management of Acid Rock Drainage as well as its effect on the underground water table and Vorotan tunnel.

The meeting will be held on the week of 15 January 2018 in the conference room of the Ministry of Nature Protection. We anticipate that meeting may last three days. Meeting participants will be Lydian international experts, representatives of Lydian Armenia, Mr. Harout Bronozian, international experts hired by Mr. Bronozian, Dr. Armen Saghatelyan, and representatives of Ministry of Nature Protection. Our anticipation is that at the end of the meeting there will be resolutions about possible Acid Rock Drainage impacts as well as potential reasonable and feasible mitigation measures. We are looking forward for a productive and informative meeting.
